Mark Mustio delivered the annual State of the Chamber address, commenting that "...this was a fun year to serve as chairman." Mustio went on to explain that he felt the Chamber had the best combination of volunteer board members, committee members and ambassadors in the Chamber's history.

Mustio, who has been involved with the Chamber for twenty years, encouraged members to continue to support future efforts, and to lean on the Chamber to help them on issues affecting their business. He noted that this past year's events allowed the Chamber to provide assistance on many community and

regional projects. The Chamber's programs and events also helped keep our Chamber's dues lower than other organizations. Additionally, about 15 percent of the Chamber's profit was derived from the State funded Team PA surveys conducted by the Board and volunteers throughout the 31 communities the Chamber serves. Those surveys helped identify additional programs and resources needed to help our members grow and support their businesses.

He also said that the Pittsburgh Airport Area Chamber is fast approaching an unprecedented 900 members.

Mark also recognized the Chamber's continued dedica-

tion to technology improvements, citing our new e-mail newsletter and referral reporting, which has increased by 61%, as we gave out over 180,000 member referrals over the past year.

Mustio stated that the Chamber's affiliated group, the Enterprise Foundation, received approval of its 501c3 exemption status during the past fiscal year, and that planning is in the early stages of how the Foundation can benefit businesses in the region.

He concluded by thanking all for their support, especially fellow officers Mike Belsky, Marcy McKivitz, Jim Stiegerwald, Brian Walker and David Goldman.


